We have been plodding away with the training schools this past year. Weina's school has developed to 42 children at the moment and this could grow with our winter program which will run over the Christmas period. Weina has developed such a reputation that the local school is sending their sometimes their difficult children to her to learn English.

One English teacher is sending her child to us because the rate of improvement of the other children has been so great.

Weina has developed board games to help the children learn English. The remarked thing is many of the boys that are attending are difficult children in school and the parents were worried about their education, but the transformation in Weina's class means these boys are loving coming. On my last trip to Williamstown I went shopping in Footscray and bought some more board games.

In another city we have another young couple Leo and Annie, just start another group in the last month. I traveled there to give them some support. At this point in time they have two children. We are making plans with them to run a training class during the school holidays.

Rocky and Faifai school has maintained it level at around 14 kids. In the photo on the left I am teaching the kids a song.
