By this stage we had been going from just after lunch into the late afternoon and the cooks were preparing supper. People were not hungry for food but our Lord. We talked about what makes a Christian and how to become a Christian. Some said they wanted to become a Christian and somewhere between 20 and 30 people prayed to accept Jesus.

The following day the newly married couple and some of their family members wanted to take us around the city to show us some of the sites. The




city has many channels which were the main way of transport many years ago. In the evening we sat down to eat and Rock lead Chang Di mother and sister to the Lord.
